Also available are three study groups meeting monthly; Basketry, Weaving, and "Sheep to Shawl" review.

As individuals, we are spinners, beginners, weavers, felters, knitters, crocheters, dyers, experts, shepherds, designers, tatters, and much, much more.

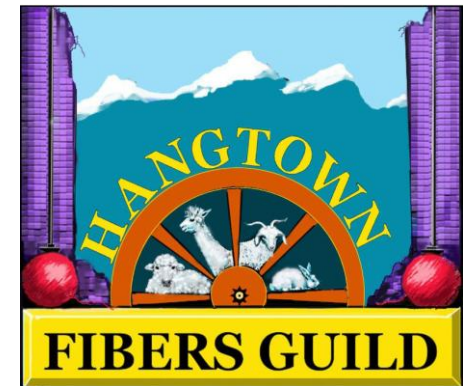
