Yahoo.com is an internet service for mail, news, and groups. People who have like interests can form groups that no one else can see or participate in, only the group members. We have our own group on Yahoo called Hangtown Fibers Guild and it's used mainly to send out timely emails to all the members and to house our stash of photos. But if you're not a member of the Yahoo Group, you won't get the email or be able to see the photos. It's pretty easy to join. You just send an email to hangtownfibersguild-subscribe@yahoogroups.com and the group administrator will check to see if you are a guild member and then grant you access. It is possible to join the Yahoo group without a Yahoo ID, but you'll only see the emails that are sent and won't have access to the pictures and any other files that may be posted in the group. You need a Yahoo ID in order to access the group online. To get a Yahoo ID go to <https://www.yahoo.com> and open a free account for yourself. For instance my Yahoo ID is Ninaclock145@yahoo.com. You'll be able to make up your own ID and protect it with a password. Then send the request to subscribe. There are 58 members currently on the Yahoo Group so I think that's a pretty good representation of the guild members, but just in case you're not one of them, come join us!
