SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Hangtown Fibers Guild is offering one (1) partial scholarship, not to exceed a maximum of \$50 for each workshop for the current year, and in the future as economically feasible.

Any guild member is eligible to apply for a scholarship for any workshop. A recipient will commit and agree to present a Committee-approved program, workshop, or outreach for the benefit of the community and/or guild within the following twelve months in exchange for this scholarship award. The program, workshop, or approved community outreach may not be related to the workshop for which the scholarship was received.

Scholarships will be awarded under several criteria, including need, desire, proposed program reciprocation, community and guild benefit, etc. **A member may be awarded only one scholarship per calendar year.** Application must be made to the Scholarship Committee no sooner than ten (10) weeks prior and no later than six (6) weeks prior to the date of the workshop for which the scholarship is applied, at the Committee's discretion.
